The Personal Property Tax Relief Act (PPTRA) credit is proposed to decrease from 65% to a 57% credit.

The Meals Tax levy is proposed to remain at 5.00% of gross receipts.

The Transient Occupancy Tax levy is proposed to remain at 5.00% of gross receipts.
